



Mansion Amenities

The historic Harwelden Mansion is a recorded Oklahoma Historic Landmark and is listed on the National Register of Historic Places. The beautiful Mansion is very unique and for this reason we ask that special care be taken when utilizing the facility

- Harwelden will comfortably hold 125 guests for an indoor/outdoor event with outdoor wedding ceremony. We can hold larger guest sizes for an event that would require less seating and tables.
- For an all-indoor event, the Mansion can hold approximately 75 people for a sit-down meal using the Grand Salon (living room) and Sun Room.
- Without tables, the Grand Salon can seat approximately 100 people for an event (wedding, concert, private party, seminar, etc.).
- Outdoor events using tents on the lawn will accommodate more guests. Contact a team member for more info
- Harwelden has 2 front parking lots that can hold 25 cars, plus 30-35 additional spaces on side streets.
 - Catering Kitchen with separate entrance for vendors
- 132 Harwelden Chavari Chairs, 100 White Resin Outdoor Chairs, 9-8' rectangle tables, 12-48" round tables, 3-60" round tables, and 20-36" bistro tables for you to use for your event (included in most rental packages)
- Harwelden is a wheelchair friendly mansion. An entrance ramp is located on the south end of the mansion and an elevator is available to access multiple levels of the mansion.
 - Public restrooms are located on the basement level..
- An On-Site Mansion Representative is a resource to you included in your venue rental for most packages. The coordinator is present to assist with vendor deliveries and oversee setup.
 - Use of the venue for a 1.5 hour engagement or bridal photo session with your photographer is included in most packages. Indoor use of the mansion would be during business hours Monday-Friday. Outdoor use of the mansion for photos will depend on events booked.
- Wi-Fi is available throughout Mansion
- Basement level Club Room (conference room) is equipped with a large screen perfect for hosting meeting
